Merge for NVivo is an add-on module for NVivo 2.

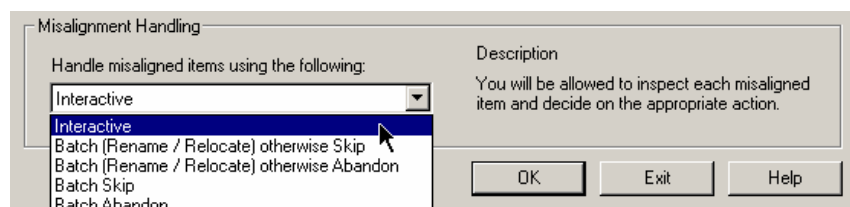
It allows you to align, compare, assess and optionally merge the results of your work from two or more NVivo 2 projects.

Merge for NVivo is a separate product and may be purchased either individually or as a bundled solution when purchasing NVivo 2. Both products have now been superseded by NVivo 7.

Are you working on a project that involves other researchers? And are all of you using NVivo 2? Merge for NVivo is an add-on module for NVivo 2 that allows you to align projects, merge analysis frameworks, and compare the analysis from different research stages or sites. It features an innovative 'alignment tool' that makes it possible to compare and reorganize projects.

Compare, reflect and review

Use the 'alignment tool' to compare one project item with another. And if you find the items are different, choose to rename, reposition or skip the item in order to complete your project merge. Any number of projects and items can be compared and brought into alignment.

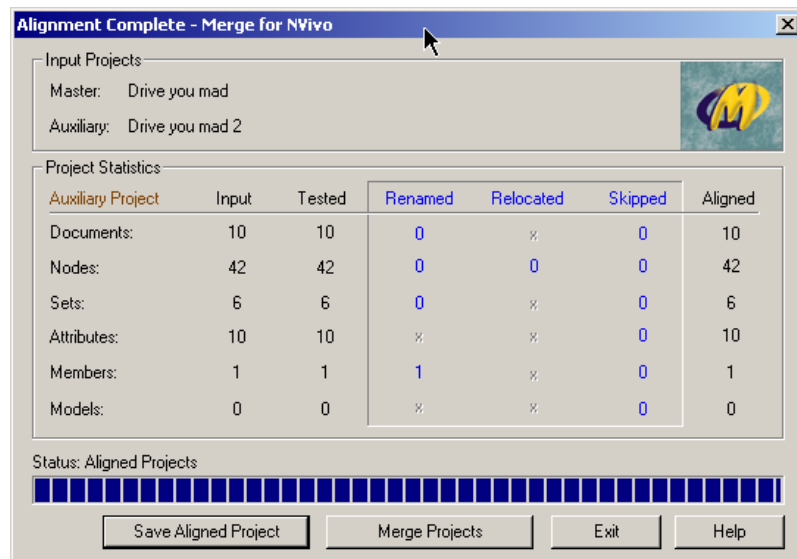


Have full control over project merging

Customize your projects to match or vary to meet your requirements, and set your own rules for what to do in the event of differences. Identify and explore variations or common themes and adapt the projects as you review them.

Size up the big picture

Align two or more projects and then view a statistics summary to discover the similarities and differences between them. You can also check for coding consistency and highlight any variations.
